Lynbrook Station Enhancement Project

What's happening?

On Tuesday, September 3, the Lynbrook Station Enhancement Project will begin. Station enhancements include but are not limited to the following:

- New platform waiting rooms
- New LED light fixtures
- New polycarbonate canopy and elevator roof
- New public address system, security cameras, signage and platform coating.

During the first phase of work, the following platform boarding changes will be in effect:

Platform A: Babylon Branch Service*

September 3-October 17: The western end of the platform, and western staircase, will be closed. Please be prepared to board/exit all trains from the first six cars during this time.

Platform B: Long Beach Branch Service*

September 3-September 29: The western end of the platform, and western staircase, will be closed. Please be prepared to board/exit all trains from the first six cars during this time.

*See schedule for exceptions.

Travel Tips:

- Allow additional time to reach the station platform.
- Listen closely for station announcements regarding track/platform assignments.
- Sign up to receive e-mail/text message alerts at mymtaalerts.com.
- Use the LIRR's new train finder tool - mylirr.org. In addition to being able to follow the progress of your train in real-time, you can learn the number of cars your train has and the track/platform on which it will arrive.

We appreciate your patience while work is underway, and will seek to complete this infrastructure improvement in the shortest timeframe possible. Stay tuned for updates as work shifts to the east end of the station.
